The Cajun Clickers Computer Club Officers and Directors will comply with the following prescribed rules of conduct. - 2. Officers and Directors will not use their club affiliation to solicit any products, equipment or favors from any business or organization or their authorized representatives without expressed authorization from the Board of Directors.**
- 3. Officers and Directors will project an attitude of courtesy and respect for other Officers, Directors and Members. They will join in a spirit of cooperation by acting in the best interest of the club at all times.**
- 4. As Officers and Directors, you are the direct link to the community. You must maintain a high degree of honesty and integrity within the community, and act in the best interest of the Cajun Clickers Computer Club at all times.**
- 5. Officers and Directors shall set examples by refraining from and discouraging the copying and distribution of copyrighted software.**
- 6. As Officers and Directors, you must project a positive influence by participating in both club and community affairs, and conduct public relations in an honest and forthright manner at all times.**
- 7. Officers and Directors will maintain policies and encourage practices that convey an attitude of trust and confidence. We will be accountable for our actions and appearance, and be examples of the highest level of personal integrity.**
